

ROUND UP TO HELP YOUR NEIGHBORS

NOVEC customers have an opportunity to make the winter holidays warmer and brighter for those who may be struggling. As the cold weather approaches, you can offer a helping hand to your neighbors just by donating some spare change.

Participants in NOVEC's Operation Round Up® (ORU) program volunteer to round up their bills each month to the next dollar. NOVEC provides these resources to local nonprofits, which in turn use the funds to assist NOVEC customers who might not otherwise be able to pay their electric bills.

Sign up for ORU online through your SmartHub account or call NOVEC's Customer Care Center at 703-335-0500. One-time donations from NOVEC customers or those outside our service territory are also welcome. Mail a check for any amount, payable to NOVEC Operation Round Up. Send to: NOVEC ORU, P.O. Box 2710, Manassas, VA 20108. More information may be found at novec.com/oru.

The "rounded up" amount averages a total of \$6 per year for each customer. Your monthly bill shows the donated amount.
