


HUNTING SAFETY TIPS TO KEEP YOU ON TARGET

As you head outdoors for hunting season this fall, NOVEC encourages you to stay alert. Overhead power lines, utility poles, and other electrical equipment may be located in or near popular hunting areas. Being aware of these hazards can help prevent serious injuries or even fatalities.

Here are a few key safety tips to keep in mind while hunting this season:

- Know your surroundings.
- **©** Keep your distance from electrical equipment.
- Never shoot near power lines or insulators.
- Mever place deer stands on utility poles.
- Do not place decoys near power lines or electrical equipment.

WAYS TO PAY YOUR NOVEC BILL



SmartHub: Customers who are registered with NOVEC's SmartHub app may pay their bills from their computers or mobile devices, through Auto Pay or a one-time payment.



Mail: When mailing your payment, use the envelope enclosed with your billing statement, and be sure to include the return portion of your bill. Write your NOVEC account number on your check.



From your personal banking

institution: Many banks, credit unions, and online banking websites allow customers to make payments for little or no cost online. You will need to have your NOVEC bill or your account number available.



Other Locations: NOVEC customers may also pay their bills at local retailers — CVS, Dollar General, Family Dollar, Walgreens, and Walmart — or at Western Union offices.



Pay by Phone: Call 844-574-1512 to pay by phone. You will be required to set up a PIN, which you will need for each subsequent payment. You can also set up Auto Pay over the phone.

Follow any directives to turn off utilities. If you're advised to switch off the main power source to your home, flip each breaker and THEN turn off the main breaker. You may also need to shut off the main valves for your home's gas and water.

If your home experiences flooding, keep the power off until an electrician has inspected your system for safety. Have an electrician inspect electrical appliances that have gotten wet, and do not turn on or plug in appliances unless an electrician tells you it is safe.

Do not touch a circuit breaker or replace a fuse with wet hands or while standing on a wet surface.

DO NOT go near any downed power lines, especially if there is standing water nearby.
